The middle school and secondary education tracks allow candidates to focus on specific content areas of most significant interest.

Completing the CP/TC Teacher Assistant prepares students for the ParaPro Assessment. This is a general aptitude test required for paraprofessional certification. Testing scores are required for paraprofessional application at each school district within Arkansas.

There is a \$75 test registration fee. Testing will need to be scheduled a week in advance. Test completion time is recommended for 2 ½ hours.
