- i Step-by-Step: Manage MFA Settings in Microsoft 365
- Step 1: Go to the Security Info Page
 - 1. Open your web browser.
 - 2. Visit: https://mysignins.microsoft.com/security-info
 - 3. Sign in with your Microsoft 365 email and password.

Step 2: Review Current Sign-In Methods

- 1. After logging in, you'll see the "Security Info" page.
- 2. This lists all your current MFA methods (e.g., phone number, email, Authenticator app, etc.).

+ Step 3: Add a New Sign-In Method

- 1. Click "+ Add sign-in method".
- 2. Choose a method:
 - Authenticator App (e.g., Microsoft Authenticator)
 - Phone Number
 - o **Email** (if allowed by admin)
 - Security Key
 - App Password (for legacy applications)
- 3. Follow the prompts to complete the setup for the method you chose.

Step 4: Change or Remove an Existing Method

- 1. To **change** a method (like a phone number), click **"Change"** next to that method.
- 2. To **remove**, click the **trash can icon** next to the method you want to delete.
- 1 You must have at least one active method on your account at all times.

🐈 Step 5: Set a Default Sign-In Method

- 1. Click the dropdown beside "Default sign-in method" at the top.
- 2. Select your preferred method (e.g., "Microsoft Authenticator notification").

Optional: Set Up Microsoft Authenticator App

- 1. If you select **Authenticator App**, download **Microsoft Authenticator** on your mobile device from:
 - o Google Play Store
 - Apple App Store
- 2. Scan the QR code shown on your screen.
- 3. Approve the test notification to finish setup.

Step 6: Sign Out and Test Your MFA

- 1. Sign out of your Microsoft 365 account.
- 2. Sign back in to test the new MFA method.
- 3. Approve the request or enter the code as prompted.

* Troubleshooting Tips

- Can't access old MFA device? Contact your IT administrator for a reset.
- "More information required" prompt? You'll be redirected to set up MFA before continuing.
- No access to manage MFA? Your admin may have restricted changes. Use your organization's helpdesk.
