**Program/Graduation Requirements and Advising Notes:**

**\*MEDL 1001 HCP CPR and First Aid**

- Must take MEDL1001 HCP CPR & First Aid or have current certification and apply for PLA for Certificate of Proficiency in CNA.
- EMS will also require MEDL1001 HCP CPR & First Aid or have current certification for licensure and program requirements, but it is not required to earn the certificate credential. However, if MEDL 1001 is taken, credit will be awarded.
- MEDL 1001 is not required to earn TC Health Professions Certificate if students choose CP in Medical Office Assistant or Concentration in Medical Lab

## **\*\* Certificate of Proficiency in Medical Office Assistant**

- Requires Comp I, Intro to Computers, Intro to Healthcare, and Business Communications to earn CP
- Students seeking Medical Lab or EMS who take Human A&P I and II may meet the 30-credit hour TC requirement without Nutrition.
- Students should choose math and A&P courses based on which health professions program they are seeking. A&P I and II should be taken at the same institution to ensure transfer.
- No Certificate of Proficiency is eligible for Federal Financial Aid. Federal Financial Aid pays for courses of students pursuing Technical Certificate and/or higher degree.
- Students should check their chosen program's description in the current catalog for possible prerequisite courses and course sequencing.

## **ARKANSAS COURSE TRANSFER SYSTEM (ACTS)**

The Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS) contains information about the transferability of courses within Arkansas public colleges and universities. Courses not having an ACTS number may also transfer. Please consult the receiving institution for complete transfer information.

### **EMT Overview**

This is a one semester program that that will prepare students for the EMT Licensure Exam and entry level employment as an EMT in the State of Arkansas. Students enrolling in the program must have ACT or equivalent scores of Reading 16, Writing 16, Math 15, or complete the appropriate remedial courses. Program courses include off-campus clinical and internship rotations. Students must maintain a C average in all courses to progress through and graduate from the program. Students will be eligible to challenge the NREMT Licensure Exam after completion of the program. Graduation does not guarantee licensure or employment as an EMT.

### **CNA Overview**

This is a one semester program that that will prepare students for the CNA Certification Exam and entry level employment as a CNA in the State of Arkansas. It is recommended that students enrolling in the program have ACT or equivalent scores of Reading 19, Writing 19, Math 15. Acceptance is based on Tier System for placement. Program courses include off-campus clinical rotations. Students must maintain a C average in all courses to progress through and graduate from the program. Students will be eligible to challenge the Arkansas CNA Exam after completion of the program. A student must be 18 years of age at the completion of the coursework for the Certified Nursing Assistant to take the licensure exam. Graduation does not guarantee certification or employment as a CNA.

### **Medical Lab Concentration Overview**

This program is to prepare students for employment in a medical lab/testing facility. It is recommended that students enrolling in the program have ACT or equivalent scores of Reading 19, Writing 19, Math 15. Program courses include off-campus clinical rotations. After completion of MEDL 1333 Phlebotomy course, students can take the certification exam through the National Healthcare Association to become a certified Phlebotomy Technician. Graduation does not guarantee certification or employment as a Medical Lab Technician.
