****Foundations of Composition: Course that combines Literacy and Advanced Writing. ENGL 0093 Foundations of Composition requires two scores: 15 ACT Reading or equivalent AND an ACT English 0-15 or equivalent.**

***** ENGL 0071 English Composition I Co-req: This course requires two scores, an ACT 16-18 or equivalent placement score in Reading AND an ACT 16-18 or equivalent placement score in English/Writing. Each English Composition I Co-req section is paired with a specific English Composition I section that students must enroll in. See Multiple Measures below.**

In the case of a student having both an ACCUPLACER Next Gen Arithmetic (AR) and a Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra, and Statistics Next Gen Algebra (QA) score, the Next Gen Arithmetic score will be used for placement.

Students with a Next Gen AR score will determine math placement into: CCAP 0010 Math, MATH 0081 AAS Math Health Professions Co-Req, MATH 0083 Foundations of Math, or MATH 0071 Quantitative Literacy Co-Req according to math track determined by degree of study.

Otherwise, students with only a QA score will be used to determine math placement.

(IF <234 Next Gen QA → Use Next Gen AR score)

***Degree seeking students scoring 0-14 Math ACT or equivalent must enroll CCAP 0010 Math and receive a “pass: before advancing to either Foundations of Math or Quantitative Literacy + Co-Requisite or AAS Math Health Profession + Co-Requisite. It is recommended for students to take a placement exam after completing CCAP.**

**AAS Math Health Profession Co-Requisite Courses: ACT 15 or equivalent placement score in Math may enroll in a Co-req course. Each Co-req course is paired with a specific AAS Math Health Profession section that students must enroll in.

*** Quantitative Literacy Co-Requisite Courses: ACT 15-18 or equivalent placement score in Math may enroll in a Co-req course. Each Co-req course is paired with a specific Quantitative Literacy section that students must enroll in. See Multiple Measures below.

****College Algebra Co-Requisite Courses: ACT 17-18 or equivalent placement score in Math may enroll in a Co-req course. Each Co-req course is paired with a specific College Algebra section that students must enroll in. See Multiple Measures below.

General Education Multiple Measures – Effective Fall 2022

MATH:

- ACT and Accuplacer for placement scores (or equivalent) **OR**
- High School GPA 3.25 GPA graduating within last **3** years **AND** Algebra 2 (or higher) with a B (or higher) = College Algebra w/co-req or Quantitative Literacy w/co-req

ENGLISH:

- ACT and Accuplacer for placement scores (or equivalent) **OR**
- High School GPA 3.25 GPA graduating within last **5** years = Comp I w/co-req **OR**
- English 12 (or higher) with a B (or Higher) = Comp I w/co-req

READING:

For students scoring into Adult Education CCAP reading, a high school GPA of 2.75 graduating within the last **5** years can be used to move student into Foundations of Composition.

Business, Trade, and Industry Multiple Measures – Effective Fall 2022

These requirements apply to the following programs:

ACT 15 Reading (or equivalent score) OR 3.0 HS GPA within the last 5 years admit with no recommendations.

ACT 14 Reading (or equivalent score) OR lower requires high school diploma and Dean approval to enroll. Student may require CCAP.

For SCC Minimum ACT 13 Reading (or equivalent score) OR 2.75 HS GPA with advisor recommendation.

- **Welding:** WELD courses
- **Industrial Maintenance:** ELEC 1104, INMT 1003, INMT 1404, GTAS 1112
- **HVAC:** HVAC courses, ELEC 1104, GTAS 1112

These requirements apply to the following programs/courses:

ACT 17 Reading (or equivalent score) or 3.25 HS GPA within the last 5 years

- **EDU courses: K-12 tech, Intro to Ed, EDUC Child Dev.**

CDA: EDCC 1001, 1003, 1013, 1023, MEDL 1011

- **No minimum Score requirements**
