General Rules and Regulations for Smiths and Hand Crafts Vendor

Completed applications with payment and photographs of hand crafts or smiths items must be submitted by **April 1, 2022**. Booths are assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Mailing applications early will improve your chances of receiving choice booth space. Advance Deposit due as soon as possible.

State of Arkansas COVID-19 Guidelines will be followed for indoor and outdoor events on festival date, April 23, 2022.

The festival committee reserves the right to reject any inappropriate work or display. Items to be sold must be handmade.

Set up will be Friday, April 22, from 12pm – 6pm and Saturday, April 23, from 7am-9am.

Vendors must be present during festival hours and cannot leave early without permission. All vendors will park vehicles in area designated by the Festival Committee during festival operation. Vehicles will not be permitted in the festival area during hours of operation.

Outdoor Vendors must furnish their own tables, chairs, coverings, signs and hardware. No merchandise or signs may be attached to buildings, walls, trees, or fences. All vendors are responsible for their own booths. City of Washington, Historic Washington State Park, Washington Fire Dept/Auxiliary and Festival Committee are not responsible for the loss or damage of any items.

The festival will provide 24-hour security, but cannot assume liability for damage, loss or theft of an individual's work.

Exhibitors must make arrangements for overnight accommodations.
